

PROCEDURE FOR FLORIDA RESIDENT FOR TUITION PURPOSES

This procedure details Indian River State College's process for validation of Florida residency for tuition purposes in compliance with the provisions of Florida Statute 1009.21 and State Board of Education Rule 6A-10.044. The submission deadline for all documentation that will be used to determine residency for tuition purposes is the day prior to the first day of classes. STATUTORY EXCEPTIONS

Some students, by statutory provisions, (e.g., military, public school teachers) may be classified as Florida residents for tuition purposes. Exceptions that may be considered eligible for resident status include:
