PART II GUIDED PATHWAYS

The Associate Degree in Health Service Management consist of 60 credit hours. Students are encouraged to work closely with their Advisors to chart a pathway for completion of the program within two years.

Students who have earned an A.A. Degree, or a preferred Associate of Science Degree, with a 2.5 grade point average can apply for the Bachelor of Science Degree in Healthcare Management.

The online B.S. Degree is an additional 36 core Healthcare Management credit hours beyond earning an A.A. or A.S. Degree, and includes a 6-credit hour Capstone course, HSA 4922.

Capstone

HSA 4922/Capstone, is an online course and integrates the knowledge, skills and abilities learned throughout the program. The course is designed to provide students with the opportunity to apply their knowledge and skills in a real-world setting. The course is a required component of the Bachelor of Science Degree in Healthcare Management.
