

Prospective Licensed Practical Nursing Students:

Your math/science preparation must be based on your individual needs. All or part of the following may be used to assist you in your preparation for the LPN Pre-Entrance Exam.

Math Preparation

Take math TABE test.

Remediate TABE, if necessary, to 657-800-scale score.

Attend review sessions offered by the ASC.

Take any necessary math classes.*

Science Preparation

Take the Diagnosis of Gaps in Science (DOGS) test. (This remediation must be done in the ASC or with books/computer materials you purchase.)

Request any available handouts needed, based on science test/DOGS test.

Take any necessary science classes.*

Attend review sessions offered by the ASC.

Reading Preparation

Take Reading TABE test to 617-800-scale score.

Language Preparation

Take Language TABE test.

Remediate TABE, if necessary; to 631-800-scale score to prepare you for the LPN Entrance Exam.

Test/Math Anxiety

View Video in ASC – "Improving Mathematics Studying and Test-Taking Skills."

Work through <u>Conquering Math Anxiety</u>, by Cynthia Arem. This book may be used in the ASC. Attend a student group to learn and practice skills to reduce test anxiety through the Health and Wellness Center. Call Patty Corey at 462-7826 for a screening to determine if this group may be helpful to you.

Take SLS 1101, "Student Success," a three-credit class that teaches basic study and test-taking skills, time-management, learning styles and much more.
